

PILLAR EQUIPMENT RENTAL GUIDELINES

- A valid driver's license is required for all rentals; and a credit card must be kept on file for incidental damages/repairs
- Payment is required at the start time of rental
- A rental agreement must be signed, and account must be established prior to pick up or delivery.
- Rates are based on an 4 or 8 hour day, 40 hour week, & 176 hour month. Rates are based on time out not time used. Additional hours will be billed accordingly.
- All equipment is delivered with a full tank of fuel. If equipment is returned without a full tank, Lessee will be billed at \$5.50 per gallon.
- Lessee is responsible for daily maintenance, unusual wear and tear and any tire repairs.
- Physical Damage & Liability Insurance is required from the Lessee for the equipment against damage, theft or vandalism.
- A certificate of insurance is needed in order to rent equipment. Lessee is required to list Pillar Equipment as an Additional Insured on the certificate.
- Lessee will return equipment in a reasonably clean condition. Lessee will be billed for excessive clean up at posted shop rates.
- Lessee is responsible for all transportation charges.
- Rental charges will continue on equipment until Pillar Equipment has been notified that the equipment is ready to be picked up; rental off-rent calls will not be pro-rated due to inclement weather.
- Prices are subject to change without notice.
- All rentals are subject to availability.

NOTE: State and local permits are additional when required.
